this task mainly involves monitoring the running of the installations, as well as their configuration and backups of data and/or equipment and system settings.

- preparation of various documents for monitoring the services provided by the contractor,
- operation and maintenance of management tools and the operation of CMMS software. The contractor shall enter the full technical description of all equipment which falls within the technical scope of the contract into the CMMS tool,
- cleaning of equipment as well as the equipment rooms provided,
- updating of plans and other documents relating to the technical installations and the future contract (reports, statistics, inventories, etc.),
- assistance and provision of support which the Parliament deems necessary for any activities related to the upgrading of installations, the set-up of new installations or equipment and the inspection or control thereof.
