South Devon Healthcare NHS Trust (the Contracting Authority) is acting as the lead on behalf of a consortium of healthcare institutions for an integrated community-wide ePrescribing, Medicines Management and Administration (EPMA) solution, including implementation, maintenance and ongoing support thereof for a period of 10 years from implementation with an exit option at 5 years.

South Devon Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust will be the Contracting Authority and Torbay and South Devon Health and Care NHS Trust, Torbay and South Devon Clinical Commissioning Group, Devon Partnership NHS Foundation Trust, Devon Doctors Limited, South Western Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust and any of their subcontractors carrying out services on their behalf will be third party beneficiaries of the contract.

The solution must directly contribute to improvements in patient care, for example by providing comprehensive decision support based on information provided by a medication safety database to support the creation and management of prescriptions and the recording of medicine administration.

The Contracting Authority are looking for functionality that will support cross community use of the EPMA solution involving Secondary Care hospitals (mental health, acute and community), healthcare workers in the Community and emergency staff.

The Authority requires functionality that provides integration and interoperation with other systems (such as GP and pharmacy systems) as fully as national and local regulation and the technical capacity of those systems permits.

The Authority's requirements are separated into Core and Additional functionality in the tender documents; Core functionality makes up the bulk of the Authority's requirements and must be available for deployment and capable of being demonstrated and tested at bid submission stage. Additional functionality is specific, minor, additional functionality identified by the

Authority as required at a later stage of the contract that must be deployable by the contractor, at the Authority's option, within 18 months of contract signature.
