The connected institutions comprise all Danish universities as well as most other research and education institutions in the country. Over the past 10 years, Forskningsnettet has built a nationwide DWDM network based on the Ribbon /ECI Apollo DWDM system. The current procurement agreement is nearing its expiration, and Forskningsnettet therefore wishes to establish a new agreement covering the procurement of modules for the network as well as the operation/support of the existing network.
