Technical and professional competency and relevant experience is required of the key personnel who will be used for this assignment.

Contract manager requirements:

At least 5 years experience within contract management.

At least 2 of these years shall include experience from contract management in operations contracts on equivalent road networks as in this contract.

Requirements for personnel with professional responsibility for activity areas:

Education or equivalent relevant practice within the function/discipline.

At least 2 years experience from work within the function/as responsible person within the activity area.

The average H1-value for the last 3 years should be lower than 10.
