The types of heating devices have been pre-selected and include a variety of technical solutions such as parallel electrical flow boilers, hot water immersion heaters and standalone intelligent Quantum electric heaters, as further detailed in the technical specification. Each installed device also requires a back-up demand measurement meter (or a standard meter + datalogger equivalent).
