- The ability for a Responsible Officer and Revalidation Lead to monitor appraisal compliance and review all necessary information within a doctor's portfolio for the purposes of making a revalidation recommendation.

The solution offered must be market ready, available 'off the shelf' and already proven to have been deployed at other customer sites.
