The service clinics may be provided between core hours (9:00 - 17:00) but where possible there should also be out of hours provision in order to meet patient need and provide patient choice.

The service will offer advice to other primary and secondary healthcare professionals as necessary.

The service will be patient-focused, safe and effective, equitable and cost effective.
