The eligibility of patients for this service is determined by the Department of Health and local Eligibility Criteria.

- Satisfy CCG's responsibility for the provision of suitable transport for eligible patients.
- Ensure patients equity of access to healthcare.
- Deliver measureable improvements in patient experience.

Non Emergency Patient Transport Services comprises the movement of patients whose condition is not considered an 'emergency' between patients' homes, hospitals, community settings or other treatment centres, for people referred for consultations, treatments or procedures. This can and should encompass a wide range of vehicle types and levels of care consistent with the patients' medical need(s).

This contract will commence on 1.9.2016 and will be let for five years. The contract is anticipated to be valued at approx GBP 6 000 000 per annum.
