— Blasting volume in the order of 45 000 m³— 60 000 m³ solid rock.

The main quantity of the rock fragments is assumed deposited on planned filling for the administration area between the access and escape tunnels. Here it is assumed there is space for approx. 40 000 m³— 50 000 m³ placed matter.

Any surplus matter beyond this is expected to be transported out of the area.
