The scope of the service will include assessment of eligibility, call handling, booking and the provision of safe non-emergency patient transport to eligible patients. The commissioners are to establish a contract for five (5) years with a potential extension of up to two (2) years. The services which are the subject of this notice are awarded under 2 contracts, 1 for the delivery of services within the Great Yarmouth and Waveney locality and 1 for Ipswich, east Suffolk and west Suffolk locality.
