The services will build on existing best practice, and focus on a community and health and social care approach. The clinical services will be delivered in an environment that provides patient care of a standard consistent with that of similar services provided elsewhere within NHS Forth Valley.

It is NHS Forth Valleys' preference that a single supplier will operate all 3 practices.

It will be important that Applicants involved in the planning and/or delivery of existing schemes and services can demonstrate that they have sufficient capacity so as not to prejudice delivery of primary medical services under any other contract an applicant may have with NHS Forth Valley or pre-existing schemes or the ability of NHS Forth Valley itself to deliver services. The successful applicant will be required to enter into a contract with NHS Forth Valley on the terms of the General Medical Services Contract ('GMS Contract') the form of which is prescribed by The National Health Service (General Medical Services Contracts) (Scotland) Regulations 2018, as amended, or replaced from time to time.
