The Contracting Authority estimates that the total extent of the requested services will be between NOK 0.5 - 4 million per annum. The extent can vary and the Contracting Authority will not be obliged to a specific volume in this contract. The Contracting Authority estimates that the total extent of the requested services will be between 500 000 NOK — 4 000 000 NOK per annum. The extent can vary and the Contracting Authority will not be obliged to a specific volume in this contract. Trades that have several Framework Agreements will rank suppliers in order of priority. The tenderer who submits the best tender and gets 1st priority will be asked first to carry out work in such a contract. If the tenderer with 1st priority cannot take on the work, the assignment will go to the tenderer with 2nd priority etc. The contract is for 2 years, with a unilateral option for the Contracting Authority to extend the contract for a further 1+1 years.
