VI.4.3. Review procedure

Tenderers may in the first instance submit their concerns regarding the procurement procedure to the Bank using the contact details under section I.1) of this contract notice. If tenderers or other interested parties believe that the EIB committed an instance of maladministration (i.e. it has failed to act in accordance with its established policies, standards and procedures, or to respect the principles of good administration), they may lodge a complaint to the EIB Group Complaints Mechanism (see <https://www.eib.org/en/about/accountability/complaints/index.htm>) within one year from the date on which the complainant could reasonably have known of the alleged action, decision or omission by the Bank. If they are not satisfied with the outcome, tenderers may ask the European Ombudsman to reexamine the EIB Group's response to their complaint (see <https://www.ombudsman.europa.eu>). Within the two months following the notification of the outcome of the procedure (award decision), tenderers may launch an action for its annulment and/or damages. Any request tenderers may make and any reply from the Bank, or any complaint for maladministration, will have neither the purpose nor the effect of suspending the time-limit for an action for annulment, nor will it open a new period for launching an action for annulment.
