North Tyneside Council secured a total of 4 052 000 GBP jointly funded by European Regional Development Funding (ERDF) and North Tyneside Council to deliver the start-up programme from March 2009 to March 2019. The objectives were to increase the number of local residents exploring enterprise and self employment as a viable career option and increase the number of people starting up in business. A further 1 650 000 GBP has been secured to extend from 1.4.2019 to December 2021. Once again this is joint funding between ERDF and North Tyneside Council.
