 - the process from the receipt and registration of orders until delivery at the customer.

- valid attestations/certificates issued by an independent body (e.g. ISO 14001, EMAS, Miljøfyrtårn or equivalent); or
 - a description of the tenderer's own environment management system. The description must, as a minimum, include the organisation's environmental policy and environmental goals.
