Documentation requirement: Credit assessment of the tenderer, not older than 6 months from the deadline for receipt of tenders. The evaluation will be based on the last known fiscal figures with an indication of how the credit rating has developed during the last three years.

Documentation requirement: An overview of the most important deliveries carried out by the tenderer in the last three years, as well as information regarding the contract value, date of delivery or execution and name of the recipient.

Requirement: Tenderers must have a functioning quality assurance/quality management system and non-conformance management system that, among other things, describes the tenderer's methods for quality assurance.

Requirement: Tenderers must have a system for managing and checking the supplier chain that enables follow-up of the requirements for ethical trade - basic human rights requirements, environment and ILO's core conventions.

Requirement: Tenderers must have systems and procedures to reduce the most important environmental impacts from its operations and must apply environmental management measures throughout the contract period. It is therefore required that the company has an environmental management system in accordance with ISO 14001 (such as Eco-Lighthouse or EMAS), and is certified with an environmental management standard (ISO 14001) or equivalent.

III.2.2. Contract performance conditions

The contracting authority requires that the tenderer's wages and working conditions are in accordance with generally applicable collective agreements or national collective agreements for the area covered by the contract. Wage and working conditions are in this context defined as provisions on minimum working hours, wages, including overtime supplements, shift and rota supplements and inconvenience supplements and coverage of expenses for journeys, food and lodgings, to the degree that such provisions are in the tariff agreement.

In its procurement regulations, Trondheim municipality has decided that requirements for pay and working conditions also apply to subcontractors. When the tender is submitted, the tenderer must confirm that the sub-contractor complies with the requirements.

Tenderers and relevant subcontractors must, when requested during the contract period, substantiate compliance with the wages and working conditions of employees who contribute to completion of the contract.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to carry out necessary sanctions if the tenderer or any subcontractor(s) do not comply with the contract clauses.
