The extent and details of these works will vary from location to location. Project works shall be awarded in separate packages based on the “Call Off” set out in the framework agreement. It is anticipated that the value of individual works packages awarded under this framework agreement will not exceed EUR 5 000 000 (including VAT).

There is no undertaking given by Iarnród Éireann that all works outlined above will be tendered under this framework agreement. Iarnród Éireann may at its discretion and where considered appropriate use alternative procurement options for such works.
