- electrical fire alarm/interface works,
- distribution board upgrades,
- remedial works and replacement of fire doors,
- emergency lighting and general lighting replacement,
- replacement ceilings that are impacted by fire works,
- redecoration,
- new build/refurbishment healthcare facilities to create suitable decant space for fire code works,
- demolition and refurbishment asbestos surveys.
