Subsequent to the submission of the tender, the tenderer must give consent for TendSign to obtain and the contracting authority to receive information on the above-named via TendSign. After tenderers have submitted their tender in TendSign, they will receive a request from Altinn for consent to share tax information. The consent is valid on an organisation level and is valid for 3 (three) months. If tenderers do not give their consent, the tenderer must attach a certificate for tax and VAT. The certificate must not be older than 6 (six) months from the tender deadline. Any arrears or other irregularities must be justified. (Tenderers can obtain the electronic tax and VAT certificate themselves and immediately receive it by email.) Foreign tenderers: Tenderers who are not established in Norway shall submit equivalent documentation issued by the authorities in the country where the tenderer is established. The certificate shall preferably be translated into Norwegian, but it will also be accepted in Swedish, Danish and English.

Documentation requirement:

The contracting authority will assess the finances of the tenderer through CreditPro. Tenderers can attach other necessary information if the tenderer believes that CreditPro does not provide a correct picture of the economic situation.

The CreditPro service includes all Nordic countries. As a main rule, the contracting authority will not accept

credit ratings from other company and account information systems than CreditPro on the grounds of

equal treatment of all tenderers. However for foreign tenderers outside the Nordic countries, the contracting authority will

use and accept a credit rating through Dun & Bradstreet Credit (via DNB,

<https://credit.dnb.com/>).

Tenderers that the contracting authority cannot find on CreditPro (or Dun & Bradstreet Credit for

tenderers outside the Nordic countries, for example, newly established tenderers that have not worked up a

basis for a credit assessment, must attach a declaration/guarantee from a parent company /owner/bank or

similar financing institution on the company's financial and economic position.
