The successful tenderer will also be required to update and supplement the 'Irish standards of modern zoo practice'. Provide On-going support to new zoos and offer training where necessary.

The successful tenderer will be required to work for up 60 days a year to a nominated officer in the Biodiversity and EU programmes unit in the Department, on the zoo inspection programme. This includes time for inspections, travel and preparatory work. The inspections

can be carried out in a single or in separate block of work. The contract will run for a 36 month period and inspections for 2018, 2019 and 2020 will need to be undertaken in that period. (Refer to Rft).
