Financial offers that deviate more than ten (10) percentage points from the average of all discounts of the admissible offers submitted are deemed to be

abnormally low. The contracting entity may consider that offers and offers with a smaller or no deviation from the above limit constitute abnormally low offers.xxxxiii i) Subsequently, the contracting entity shall notify the decision to approve the minutes to all tenderers except those who were definitively excluded due to failure to submit or produce the original participation guarantee, in accordance with case (c) of this paragraph 4.1 and shall provide access to the submitted data of the other tenderers. Any interested party who has or had an interest in being awarded the specific public contract and has suffered or may suffer damage from an enforceable act or omission of the contracting entity in violation of European Union or domestic legislation in the field of public procurement, has the right to appeal to the Authority for Preliminary Appeals (AEPP), in accordance with the specific provisions of articles 345 et seq. of Law 4412/2016 and 1 et seq. of Presidential Decree 39/2017, by filing a preliminary appeal against an act or omission of the contracting entity, specifically specifying the legal and factual objections that justify his requestlvii. The preliminary appeal is mandatory drawn up using the standard form of Annex I of Presidential Decree 39/2017 and is submitted electronically in the electronic area of the specific tender through the "Communication" functionality of the subsystem to the contracting entity, by selecting the indication "Preliminary Appeal" in accordance with article 15 of the Joint Ministerial Decree ESIDIS-Public Works. The deadlines for the submission of preliminary appeals and interventions begin on the day following the day of the aforementioned notification or knowledge, as the case may be, and expire when the last full day and time 23:59:59 have passed and, if this is an exception or a Saturday, when the next full working day and time 23:59:59 have passed.
