Salten Brann IKS is the contracting authority for the contest. Salten Brann IKS is an inter-municipal fire and rescue company owned by Beiarn, Bodø, Fauske, Gildeskål, Hamarøy, Meløy, Saltdal, Steigen, Sørfold, and Værøy Municipalities. The region has more than 80,000 inhabitants spread over a large geographical area.

Salten Brann has its main office in Bodø and has more than 350 employees in both full time and part time positions. The company is, amongst other things, responsible for the 110 emergency message service for 41 municipalities in Nordland and South Troms, equivalent to a population of 280,000 inhabitants.

Salten Brann would like to enter into a contract with a tenderer for the delivery of a specially adapted mobile training module for Kvalvika training ground, based on a 20 foot container. It must be possible to transport the module on the company's hook lift vehicles, and it will be used for training activities in the fire service. The aim of the procurement is to achieve greater flexibility for training activities.

REQUIREMENT: Tenderers must have their tax, payroll tax and VAT payments in order.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENT: A tax certificate, not older than six months from the tender deadline. For Norwegian tenderers: A tax and VAT certificate issued by the Tax Collection Office via Altinn. Foreign tenderers: Foreign tenderers must submit equivalent certificates from their own country that show that they have an arrangement for the payment of taxes and duties. If the authorities in the relevant country do not issue such certificates, the tenderer should submit a declaration stating that all taxes and duties have been paid. Tenderers must have the financial strength to fulfil the contract.

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

REQUIREMENT: Tenderers must have sufficient financial strength to fulfil the contract.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENT: The tenderer's annual accounts including notes with the boards and auditor's reports from 2021 and 2022. If the annual accounts for last year have not been completed by the tender deadline for this contest, the provisional annual accounts for last years must also be attached. If there are justifiable reasons as to why the provisional annual accounts cannot be attached, tenderers must document their financial standing in another appropriate way. The contracting authority reserves the right to undertake a credit rating from Experian. Financial strength will be assessed in terms of turnover, operating margin, solidity, and liquidity. The contracting authority will obtain the revised annual accounts from the Brønnøysund Register Centre for Norwegian tenderers. Norwegian tenderers do not, therefore, need to submit their revised annual accounts.

REQUIREMENT: Tenderers must have experience from relevant and comparable deliveries. Relevant and comparable deliveries mean assignments of an equivalent nature, complexity, and size. DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENT: An overview of up to 3 relevant and comparable deliveries that the tenderer has carried out in the last 5 years. The overview of the deliveries must, as a minimum, include the following: Name of the contracting authority, date of execution, scope of the delivery in monetary amount and/or hours, and a description of the assignment. Complete annex 3 Reference Descriptions as documentation. REQUIREMENT: Tenderers must have implemented a quality management system. Tenderers cannot rely on sub-suppliers to fulfil this requirement. DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENT: A short description of the tenderer's quality management system that shows that the tenderer has implemented it.

If a tenderer is certified in accordance with ISO 9001 or equivalent quality assurance certificate, it is sufficient to attach a copy of the valid certificate. REQUIREMENT: Tenderers must have a documented environment management system.

Tenderers cannot rely on sub-suppliers to fulfil this requirement. DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENT: A short description of the tenderer's environment system that shows that it has been implemented by the tenderer.

If a tenderer is certified in accordance with a public certification body (the Eco-Management and Audit Scheme (EMAS), the Eco-Lighthouse scheme, ISO 14001 or other recognised environment management system/standard), it is sufficient to attach a copy of the valid certificate.
