If a tenderer is certified, it is sufficient to enclose a copy of a certificate issued by independent bodies, which confirms compliance with certain environmental management standards.

3) Requirement: Tenderers must have experience with equivalent deliveries and assignments within the sub-contracts that a tender is submitted for.

Documentation: An overview that includes the most important deliveries or services performed in the last 3 years, connected to the sub-contracts that a tender is submitted for, including a description of the assignment, information on its value, date and the name of the recipient.

4) Requirement: Tenderers must have a good implementation ability

Documentation: An account of the available workforce (administrative management and other employees) that the tenderer has at his disposal for fulfilment of the contract. State the number of resources per trade group as requested. E.g. competence matrix that shows that number of employees, position and trade.
