Gas and powder apparatuses must be dismantled by the Contracting Authority for maintenance and sent to the Tenderer.

The maintenance services and spare parts procured under the agreement shall ensure that the Contracting Authority's fire extinguishers and fire protection systems are functional and operational at all times.
