- to ensure adequate staffing, to manage sites, maximise re-use and recycling, minimise non-recyclable materials and direct, assist and educate customers in using the Household Waste Recycling Centres correctly,
- to operate the Authorities permit and barrier systems,
- to procure a Producer Compliance Scheme as detailed in Section 43 of the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations and operate such service to fulfil the Council's obligations under the WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2006) directive and any subsequent amendments and Contractual arrangements,
