3. Monitoring chemical and hygienic/bacteriological conditions in Mjøsa's six largest feed rivers and the outflow river Vormå, as well as biological surveys in the 11 largest feed rivers and Vormå on a rolling programme.
4. Monitoring selected pollutants (heavy metals and organic compounds) in two of the largest feed rivers on a rolling programme.
5. Reporting, including various presentations and entering all data into the database Vannmiljø. See the tender documentation for further information on the scope and content of the procurement.
