### **II.2.4. Description of the procurement**

The Norwegian Environment Agency will establish a dynamic purchasing system (DPS) for future procurements of mapping services in accordance with the Nature in Norway system (NiN). At first this involves a terrestrial mapping. In time, the scheme can also include limnic mapping.

The contract includes assignments for mapping of ecosystems in Norway in given geographical areas, as well as a limited registration of species in each ecosystem locality. The purpose of the assignment is to obtain ecosystem data by field mapping in accordance with the Norwegian Environment Agency's instructions for mapping of ecosystem types (annex A) and to determine the ecological quality in the mapped locations. The mapping must be carried out in accordance with the Norwegian Environment Agency's instructions for mapping ecosystems. There can be annual updates to the instructions. The instructions describe mapping ecosystems in accordance with NiN as the mapping is to be carried out in assignments for the Norwegian Environment Agency. The instructions describe the ecosystems that are to be mapped and they describe how to determine the locality quality. The Norwegian Environment Agency's instructions supplement the current versions of the Species Databank's guidelines for mapping nature variations in accordance with NiN. The recordings will be used as a knowledge base for area management, and will be published by the Norwegian Environment Agency.

The Norwegian Environment Agency's professional system for managing NiN data, (annexes B and C) will be used in the mapping.

Tenderers must have experience from assignments with mapping ecosystems based on the Nature in Norway system (NiN). The experience must be based on assignments from terrestrial mapping in accordance with the Norwegian Environment Agency's instructions from 2018, basic mapping in protected areas from 2015, other terrestrial/limnic NiN based mapping in accordance with instructions from the Norwegian Environment Agency  
And/or MiS-NiN.

Documentation: a description of the tenderer's up to 3 most relevant contracts in the last 3 years. The list must include a statement of the assignment's value, date and recipient (name, telephone number and e-mail address). It is the tenderer's responsibility to document experience and relevance through the description. Tenderers must document experience by referring to the competence of personnel that are at the disposal of the contracting authority. A commitment statement from any sub-suppliers is required.

Documentation: tenderers can rely on other companies' capacity to fulfil one or more of the qualification requirements.

The following documentation is required for the use of sub-suppliers:

- a commitment statement from relevant sub-supplier(s),
- descriptions of what necessary resources the sub-supplier(s) provide,
- a completed ESPD form for relevant sub-supplier(s).

Tenderers must have the necessary technical equipment available for fulfilment of the contract /assignment.

Documentation: Confirmation that the tenderer will use his own technical equipment that the ecosystem mapping requires for field registrations.
