The rating must be based on the last known accounting figures and it must be carried out by a credit information agency with permissions thereof.

It is the tenderer's responsibility to confirm relevance through the description.

Tenderers must have sufficient ability and capacity to implement the contract obligations.

Documentation requirement: A statement of the tenderer's average annual workforce and the number of employees in the management in the last 3 years.

Tenderers must have resources that, as a minimum, have competence that fulfils development class 3 in the applicable building regulations (SAK 10) for the engineering design function for the following areas of responsibility:

Sub-tender 1: Roads, outside areas and landscape design

Sub-tenders 2 and 3: Water supply and sewage plants

Documentation requirements: Information on the education and professional qualifications of offered personnel who will carry out assignments must be given the tab 'Sub-tender Resources' in Annex 3 Price Sheet.

Tenderers must have a good and well-functioning quality assurance system.

Documentation Requirement: Report on the tenderer's quality assurance system and procedures documenting that the requirement is met. If this is described in the tenderer's quality assurance system in accordance with, for example, ISO 9001 or equivalent third party verified system, it is sufficient to present a valid certificate.
