— maintaining dialogue with the HCC project team throughout the project to ensure efficient and timely delivery of the project requirements,

- managing resources across the relevant geographic area, ensuring that systems and structures are in place to distribute work required for the flock and herd health project to individual vets,
- providing administrative and coordination support to the project in order to ensure that paperwork and activity records are received on time and to the correct standard,
- organising and undertaking veterinary visits to draw up health plans and actions required to farms,
- coordinating invoicing to pay for veterinary review visits undertaken,
- ensuring all veterinary surgeons undertaking farm visits have the appropriate qualifications and necessary experience in flock and herd health plans,
- dealing with any issues that arise relating to the delivery of veterinary services for the project and implementing any changes that may be needed,
- providing personnel with required expertise to participate in knowledge transfer events for farmers involved in the project incorporating sheep and cattle health issues identified through the project,
- maintaining accurate records of visits and providing summary reports on the delivery of the service as requested.
