The Authority understands Leonardo UK Ltd exclusively holds all necessary drawings and specialist tooling for the Drivers Display Units LRU's; night vision systems; CCD cameras; Gunners' Auxiliary Sights; EZIVIEW vision blocks and driver control panels; and TICM modules that are the subject of this contract. The Authority understands that no other economic operator possesses the proprietary drawings, tooling and technical know-how necessary to fulfil the contract requirements.
