NPI would like to update or made a new website for np.int, but has a low budget. The price for this option is therefore very important when deciding whether or not to take up the option.
- Velgekte.no: The Patent Office is responsible for and runs the website, which is a collaboration between the Patent Office, Customs, and the Ministry of Culture and Equality. Velgekte.no presents information on pirat copying and brand falsification from public authorities. Velgekte.no is also on the current on premises CMS system and must be transferred to a new platform. It can be that we would like the content to be updated in this work.
- Intranet: The Patent Office currently has Epi (an older version that what patentstyret.no has). It can be that we would like to use the same platform (CMS) for the intranet.
