The National Genome Center (NGC) is established as an element of the realisation of the National Strategy for Personalised Medicine 2017–2020 and is intended to ensure governance and coordination of the strategy's initiatives at the national level. The Danish efforts within Personalised Medicine are to focus on the patients. The vision of NGC is to create a foundation for the development of a more precise diagnosis, targeted treatment and strengthened research within the Danish healthcare system. To achieve this vision, the core mission of the NGC, is to establish and operate a state-of-the-art and secure national infrastructure for personalised medicine in cooperation with the Regions and universities. The NGC will perform whole genome sequencing and bioinformatics analysis of samples from the regional healthcare system.
