B) Tenderers must submit documentation on their quality assurance and management system.

Certificate of the company's quality system/management system, issued by independent bodies that confirm that the tenderer fulfils quality assurance standards in accordance with ISO 9001 or equivalent,

or

A description that, as a minimum, covers the company's procedures/routines for:

- Dealing with deviations and claims
- The process from the receipt and registration of orders until delivery at the customer.

C) Tenderers must submit documentation of their environment management system. The following documentation will be accepted:

- Valid attestation/certificates issued by independent bodies (e.g. ISO 14001, EMAS, Miljøfyrtårn or equivalent systems), or

- A description of the tenderer's own environmental management system. The description must, as a minimum, include an environmental policy.

D) Tenderers must submit documentation of traceability in the supplier chain. The following documentation will be accepted: If a tenderer uses subcontractors to fulfil this contract, the

tenderer must have a method for traceability that provides the contracting authority with an overview of which subcontractors are participating in the production of the product and what country the subcontractors are in at all times.
