- to meet the requirements of the code of practice for victims of crime and articles 8 and 9 of the EU directive 2012/29/EU, this established minimum standards of support to victims of crime,
- voice is the brand to be used at all times. Guidelines are included in Appendix B of the Specification (Section 3). This is to ensure community recognition of victim and witness support services and ensure consistency of communication with them,
- to actively participate in service user panels as a part of the wider governance arrangements to support Voice in the wider design of victim and witness support services,
- support children and young people whose cases are going through the court process till conclusion of the case,
- work alongside the offer to adults from voice to ensure cross referrals and seamless transition into adult services.
