II.1.3. Type of contract

II.1.4. Short description

The contracting authority is the Agency for Urban Environment. The Agency is the municipality's professional body in relation to roads, road traffic and public transport on roads. The contracting authority is responsible for the municipal roads network, including the standardised county roads network. The contracting authority is also responsible for long-term public transport planning, traffic and street plans, traffic safety measures and plans for practicable public transport traffic measures. An important part of this administrative responsibility is related to the procurement of services for the operation and maintenance of the road network in order to ensure good conditions for all road users.

The objective of the contract is to renovate the asphalt surface on roads, streets, pavements, foot and cycle paths that are administered by the contracting authority to ensure the infrastructure and former investments as well as improve the roads standard. The work includes the necessary preparatory work such as resetting of curbs and other necessary and appropriate actions in relation to resurfacing.

The works comprise resurfacing roads, streets, pavements, pedestrian and cycle paths, as well as all necessary preliminary works related to this. See the proposal of how the work is planned executed in 2021. The proposed roads are listed in Annex 5. Laying red asphalt in cycle lanes/cycle boxes is included in the assignment. The description of the purpose and extent is not exhaustive. A detailed description of the processes included in the assignment is in Annex 1: the Requirement specification. The ordinary budget was approx. NOK 65 million on the day the tender notice was published. In case of any additional funding, the contracting authority reserves the right to increase the extent of the contract. There is as yet no knowledge of the extent of any additional funding over the 2021 asphalt budget.

This contract is not exclusive and the contracting authority reserves the right to enter into other contracts for execution of works if deemed suitable.

If a tenderer is certified, a copy of a certificate issued by the certification body shall be submitted.

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

1) Tenderers must have satisfactory capacity and competence to carry out the contract. The key person(s) must have good knowledge about the asphaltting discipline.

2) The tenderer must have experience from corresponding assignments.

3) The tenderer must have an established environmental management system.

4) The tenderer must have an established quality assurance system.
