If climate and environmental considerations were instead used as the award criteria, the contracting authority would not be able to ensure that the chosen tenderer or concrete deliveries fulfilled this level, as the price and other award criteria could be decisive. The contracting authority has assessed that the relevant requirements are relevant, proportional and possible to fulfil in the market. Based on this, it is considered clear that the climate and environmental requirements in the requirement specifications provide a better overall climate and environmental effect than the use of climate and environmental considerations as the award criterion.
