The tenderer does not need to submit documentation. If a tenderer knows that the requirement for economic ability to execute the contract cannot be met via the credit information as specified above, this can be compensated for with a parent company guarantee or bank guarantee or other documentation that the contracting authority can approve.

Tenderers must have experience from equivalent assignments. Documentation: Tenderers must attach a list of the three most important and most relevant assignments from the previous five years. The list must contain information about the assignment, value, time and recipient (name of customer) including the name and e-mail address of the contact person for at least two of these. References must be contactable if there is a need to clarify the relevance of the assignment. However, it is the tenderer's responsibility to substantiate relevance through the description.
