The tenderer must verify this by presenting a copy of the named welders' certificates that are intended to be included in this agreement.

- The tenderer must follow the correct welding procedures.

The tenderer must substantiate this with either an overview of which relevant welding procedures the tenderer follows, or a copy of the relevant welding procedures.

- The tenderer must be able to carry out third-party inspections.

The tenderer must substantiate this by stating the name of the provider that performs third-party inspections. The third party provider must also submit own ESPD as well as a declaration of commitment.

- Tenderers must have a good and well-functioning management system for quality and the environment.

The tenderer must verify this with a description of existing routines and measures. If routines are described in the tenderer's quality or environmental management system in accordance with ISO 14001, EMAS or other third party verified systems, it is sufficient to submit a copy of the certificate.
