Only candidates found qualified and selected under the criteria stated will receive an invitation to tender (ITT). The primary purpose of the candidate's design, development and production of a TEB system shall be for:

- single-span bridge,
- multi-span bridge,
- floating bridge,
- transport solutions.

NDMA shall require the candidate's commitment to provide the security of supply of parts for the useful life of the TEB estimated to be a period of 30 years. This support of the TEB's useful life for spare parts may be regulated in a separate agreement.
