- 5) to assess, with an EQA, the proficiency of laboratories for the species identification and phenotypic and genotypic resistance testing for *A. baumannii*;
- 6) to support the development of technical capability and proficiency for genomic-based surveillance and risk assessment of multidrug-resistant bacteria with epidemic potential.
