- A credit rating based on the most recent financial figures. The rating must be carried out by a credit rating agency with a licence to provide such service.

Creditworthiness with no requirement for guarantees will be sufficient to meet the requirement.

Documentation requirement:

Description of up to three of the tenderer's most relevant/comparable assignments in the last three years. The description must include a statement of the assignment value, dates and recipients (name, telephone number and e-mail address). It is the tenderer's responsibility to document relevance through the description. Tenderers can document experience by referring to the competence of personnel at disposal for this assignment, including experience that has been acquired while personnel performed services for another supplier.

B. The tenderer must present a declaration of commitment for any businesses on which the tenderer relies, cf. the Contest Rules

C. Tenderers must have a good and well-functioning quality assurance and management system for the provided services

Documentation requirement:

Tenderers must submit documentation of the quality assurance system and management system. The following documentation will be accepted:

Certificate of the company's quality system/management system, issued by independent bodies that confirm that the tenderer fulfils quality assurance standards in accordance with ISO 9001 or equivalent,

or

A description that, as a minimum, covers the company's procedures/routines for:

- Dealing with deviations and claims
- The process from the receipt and registration of orders until delivery at the customer.

D. Qualification Requirement:

Tenderers must have an established environmental management system.

Documentation requirement:

Tenderers must submit documentation of their environmental management system. The following documentation will be accepted:

- Valid attestation/certificates issued by independent bodies (e.g. ISO 14001, EMAS, Miljøfyrtårn or equivalent systems), or
