The procurement will follow the rules for an open tender contest in accordance with the Public Procurements Act and regulations (FOA) parts 1 and 3, and will be made electronically in the contracting authority's electronic contest management tool, CTM (EU-Supply).

The aim is to enter into a contract for the delivery of 40,000 doses of enhanced 4-valent influenza vaccines. The tender documentation specifies the minimum requirements for the vaccine.
