II.2.4. Description of the procurement

Sandnes, Sola, Stavanger and Randaberg Municipalities, as well as Sandnes and Sola joint church council, invites tenderers to a tender contest for a framework agreement for the delivery of plumbing services and associated material.

The framework agreement is for plumbing services with the accompanying materials for the maintenance and renovation of municipal buildings, sites and residences. The framework agreement also includes the procurement of plumbing material for work that the municipalities will carry out themselves.

All municipal units and businesses can enter the agreement.

The buildings consist of, amongst other things, administration buildings, schools, nurseries, residential and activity centres, nursing and old peoples' homes, swimming pools and sports centres, flats, office buildings, arts centres, municipal rental properties, health stations, church buildings, etc.

The tender contest contains environmental requirements, including requirements that all vehicles up to 3500kg involved in this contract from the start of the second contract year, calculated from the date the contract was entered into, must be emission-free, i.e. electric or hydrogen-powered.

III.1. Conditions for participation

III.1.1. Suitability to pursue the professional activity, including requirements relating to enrolment on professional or trade registers

List and brief description of conditions:

Company registration certificate:

Requirement: Tenderers must be a legally established company.

Documentation: Norwegian tenderers: Company Registration Certificate from the Brønnøysund Register Centre.

Foreign tenderers: Registration certificate in a professional register as determined by legislation in the country where the tenderer is established.

Tax and VAT certificates:

Requirement: Tenderers must have their tax and VAT payments in order.

Documentation: Norwegian companies: Tax and VAT certificate, not older than 6 months calculated from the tender deadline (<https://www.altinn.no/no/Skjema-og-tjenester/Etater/Skatteetaten/Attestbestilling/>).

Foreign tenderers: Certificate issued by the relevant authority in the tenderer's home state, confirming that the tenderer has met its obligations regarding tax and VAT payments. The certificate must not be more than 6 months old when calculated from the tender deadline.

III.1.2. Economic and financial standing

List and brief description of selection criteria:

Requirements relating to the tenderer's economic and financial capacity, turnover requirements:

Requirement: Tenderers must have sufficient economic and financial capacity to be able to fulfil the contract. Tenderers must, as a minimum, achieve a rating of credit worthy, and must have minimum NOK 44 million in working income in the last available fiscal years.

Documentation: Norwegian Companies: The contracting authority will obtain the credit rating, Commercial Delphi Score from Experian as documentation. Tenderers must as a minimum achieve a rating of 'Credit worthy', i.e. the tenderer must be in risk classification five or higher on the Experian scale. Alternatively, when submitting a tender offer, tenderers can enclose an updated credit rating from an approved credit rating company demonstrating that the tenderer has achieved an equivalent credit level. The credit rating must show the current economic situation of the company.

If the tenderer has valid reasons for not being able to provide the documentation requested by the contracting authority, the tenderer can prove his economic and financial position with any other document that the contracting authority deems suitable.

Foreign companies: A credit rating from a recognised credit rating company showing that the tenderer fulfils the requirement. The credit rating must be based on the most recent available accounts and it must be carried out by an agency licensed to carry out credit rating activity.

In cases where a tenderer will rely on another company's capacity to qualify, such companies must fulfil the same turnover requirements that are mentioned above.

III.1.3. Technical and professional ability

List and brief description of selection criteria:

Tenderers' technical and professional qualifications.

Requirements relating to the tenderer's experience:

Requirement: Tenderers must have experience from three relevant assignments in the last 5 years for the delivery of plumbing services with accompanying materials of a comparable size and complexity.

Documentation. Tenderers must attach a completed list to their tender, see Reference Assignments, part II, Contract Basis, chapter G Annex 3, of three relevant assignments in order of priority.

In addition tenderers must attach a list of all relevant assignments.

Tenderers must state the name, role, and contact details for a reference for the assignments.

The references will only be contacted if required.

Several smaller, relevant assignments can, in total, give a tenderer an equivalent qualification.

Requirements relating to the tenderer's capacity and implementation ability:

Requirement: Tenderers must have sufficient capacity, the necessary qualifications, and the implementation ability to fulfil the contract as described in the tender documentation.

Documentation: A short description must be attached to the tender, showing that the tenderer has sufficient capacity and implementation ability to fulfil the contract.

The description must, amongst other thing, show the tenderer's staffing level, technical personnel, organisation, or technical units, etc., that the tenderer can use to fulfil the contract, whether they belong to the company or not.

An organisation plan showing key personnel that the tenderer has put aside and will use for this framework agreement must also be presented as part of the description.

CVs must be submitted for the offered persons. The same person can have several roles.

Requirements relating to the tenderer's quality system:

Requirement: The contracting authority requires tenderers to have a well-functioning system for ensuring quality customised to the assignment's nature and scope.

Documentation: Certificate for the company's quality system/management system issued by competent independent bodies confirming that the tenderer fulfils recognised quality assurance standards such as ISO 9001:2015 or equivalent must be presented as documentation.

The contracting authority also accepts other documentation that demonstrates the tenderer has a well functioning system for ensuring quality appropriate for the nature and scope of the assignment. As a minimum, tenderers must present a general description of the contents of the system including an overview of control plans and check-lists that are relevant for this assignment.

Requirements connected to the tenderer's environmental management system:

Requirement: Tenderers must have an environmental management system which guarantees that the tenderer is able to comply with environmental requirements given in the tender documentation and the contractual obligations.

Documentation: Certificates for relevant environmental certification such as ISO 14001:2015 or EMAS, Eco-Lighthouse, or other documentation must be presented as documentation.

The contracting authority will also accept other documentation that demonstrates that the tenderer has a well-functioning environmental management measures, adapted to the nature and scope of the assignment.

Tenderers must present a brief statement stating the tenderer's environmental objectives, status of in-house environmental work, and planned measures of relevance to this contract, see part II Contract Basis, chapter B.2.6 Environment for further information.
