With regard to the TPs, the pre-transport from Newcastle to Eemshaven is also covered under the CAR insurance, the MWS objective here checks the lifting/loading onto the barge in Newcastle, the pre-transport from Newcastle to Eemshaven and unloading from the barge onto the quay edge in Eemshaven as well as the pre-transport of the TPs from the quay edge (load-in area) to the "final storage area" in Eemshaven and back to the quay edge. The corresponding document checks are also part of this scope.
