The project is expected to be of use for both civil and military fuel preparedness.

The project will result in a final report that must include concrete recommendations on measures that can avert identified vulnerabilities, submitted by 16 June 2023.

The Ministry of Trade, Industry, and Fisheries (NFD) would like to enter into a contract for an analysis of possible preparedness consequences resulting from structural changes in the refinery industry.

The risk and vulnerability analysis project of structural changes in the refinery industry shall highlight what consequences reduced production capacity in Norway and Europe have for national supply security for fuel, and identify relevant measures to deal with any vulnerabilities. The aim of the analysis is to give the ministry a good knowledge basis in order to assess the dimensioning of the national fuel preparedness, in the light of the structural changes that come from the green change and in a time of greater uncertainty as regards international trade systems and European security. The project is expected to be of use for both civil and military fuel preparedness.
