The tenderer must be able to handle ordering licenses within the entire Microsoft contract portfolio, including EA, MPSA and MCA contracts, and assist the contracting authority with services related to license management. Furthermore, the tenderer must assist as needed with renegotiating existing contracts and entering into or creating other Microsoft contracts such as MPSA and MCA.
