Section V.2.4 of the tender notice).

Unit price (Price per dose) is the only price element in the contest. The contracting authority considers unit prices to be information of competitive importance to keep secret from the person to whom the information relates, who in this case is the vaccine supplier that has been awarded sub-contracts after the contest. If the real sub-contract values had been published in the tender notice, it would have been possible to calculate the unit price based on the contract value and publicly known information about the number of doses in the contract.

The contracting authority informs that the contract value is above the Public Procurement Regulations' upper threshold value and lower than the estimated procurement value, cf. Section II.1.7)
