this requirement. The training is greatly enhanced through the participation of civilian role players

who can accurately replicate cultural, ethnical, and linguistic aspects of Host Nation Government

(HNG), Non-Government Organizations/International Agencies (NGOs), as well as the general civilian populace in a variety of scenarios.
