In this connection, Fagne wishes to enter into a contract with a supplier for the procurement of materials as well as the construction of overhead power lines along parts of the route. The overhead power lines constitute approximately 4 km of the total 7 km route. The procurement also includes the dismantling of the existing cable termination tower in Ersvika further north on Tysnes, as well as the procurement of materials and the construction of a new cable termination tower, and the rebuilding of a suspension tower, including conductor stringing. Any negotiations may be conducted in several phases or rounds of negotiations, and the Contracting Authority reserves the right to reduce the number of tenders to be negotiated.
