VI.4.3. Review procedure

Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures:

If a dispute occurs between the parties on the interpretation or legal consequences of the contract, an attempt to solve the dispute through negotiations must be tried first. If the negotiations are not successful, the matter will be decided in an ordinary law court, unless the parties agree on a decision via arbitration. Arbitration must in such a case be petitioned within 14 days of the parties agreeing on arbitration proceedings.

In the event of arbitration, each party is to appoint an arbitrator, and the appointed arbitrator will jointly appoint an arbitrator. If a party does not appoint an arbitrator, or the arbitrators do not agree on an arbitrator, the appointment will be made by the chief judge in Trondheim lawcourt.

The arbitration court's appointment and case proceeding will follow the provisions in the Act dated 13 August 1915 no. 6 on the court proceedings method for disputes, chapter 32. Trondheim is the legal venue for any proceedings for the parties in the contract and the guarantors, and notification must be given as for those who reside in the city. Dispute or arbitration resolutions must be based on Norwegian law.
